We will be learning to:

- Work with a partner throwing and catching a ball.
- Move freely with pleasure in a range of ways such as running, jumping, hopping and sliding.
- Balance a bean bag on different parts of our bodies.
- To listen carefully to instructions and follow the actions.
- Find a space.

Literacy

We will be learning to:

Reading

- Listen to our favourite fairy tales and be able to explain what is happening at the beginning, middle and end of the story.
- Repeat words and key phrases from the stories.
- Look at books and understand that we read the print from left to right.

Writing

- Trace and copy letters from our name.
- Hold a pencil correctly.

Phonics

- Recognise words that rhyme e.g. Rug, mug and slug.
- Recognise words that have the same beginning sound e.g. snake, sock and spider.

ICT

We will be learning to:

- Click and drag the mouse when playing educational games on the computer.
- Control and navigate remote control gadgets e.g. bee bots and remote control cars.

Communication and Language

We will be learning to:

- Re-tell our favourite stories using puppets and a variety of props.
- Join in with repeated phrases from stories.
- Talk about what we think may happen next.
- Answer questions using a full sentence.
- Talk to a partner and listen to what each other has to say.
