

HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT

Braunstone Community Primary School's Home School Agreement sets out the school's responsibilities towards its pupils, the responsibilities of the pupil's parents and what the school expects of its pupils.

The aim is to strengthen the partnership between home and school and makes clear the respective roles and expectations.

The school will make every effort to:

- Care for your child's safety and happiness
- Ensure that the child achieves his/her potential as a valued member of the school community
- Provide a balanced curriculum and meet the individual needs of your child
- Achieve high standards of work and behaviour through building good relationships and developing a sense of responsibility
- Keep you informed about general school matters
- Keep you informed about your child's progress
- Be open and welcoming at all times and offer opportunities for you to become involved on the daily life of the school.

Parents / Carers will make every effort to:

- See that my child attends school every day, be on time and properly equipped
- Be aware that there is a link between my child's attendance and their achievement
- Make the school aware of any problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour
- Consult with the school before planning extended travel overseas
- Make sure that my child wears the correct school uniform and PE kit with correctly fitting sensible black school shoes :
School uniform: grey trousers/skirt, white polo t-shirt, navy blue school sweat shirt/cardigan/fleece with the school logo, plain grey/black or navy blue tights, blue and white checked summer dress and plain white/grey/black/navy blue socks
P.E. Kit: change of white t-shirt, navy blue shorts, trainers (preferable) or plimsolls
- Make sure that my child has a suitable bag for reading books and PE kit (these are available from the school office)
- Label my child's belongings clearly with their name

- Support my child in homework and other opportunities for home learning
- Attend parent's evenings and discussions about my child's progress
- Read, sign and return letters promptly
- Inform the school quickly if my child is absent.

Children will make every effort to:

- Keep myself safe on the way to school and when I go home
 - Help to keep the school clean and tidy and put things in their proper places
 - Follow instructions and listen to all adults straight away in school
 - Play in the playgrounds and use the toilets sensibly
 - Respect other people and their property
 - Attend school daily and on time, work hard and not interrupt others while they are working
 - Try to be a good friend to others
 - Tell a grown up if someone is making me unhappy.
 - Complete and return homework
 - Have the right attitude/behaviours to be a learner.
 - Take responsibility for their own learning.

We listen – we don't interrupt

We are honest – we 'Own Up' if things go wrong

We work hard – we don't waste our own or others' time
