In PE, our topic will be movement.

English

We will be answering the following questions;

- Can I remember my reading strategies?
- Can I hold a pencil correctly?
- Can I use the sounds I know when writing?
- Can I begin to punctuate my sentences with capital letters, full stops and question marks?

In addition, each day we will be doing Phase 5 phonics.

We will send levelled reading books home. Please read with your child daily making sure to sign their reading passport.

Science

In Science, our topic is **Scientific Enquiry** where we will be answering the following questions;

- Can I perform experiments using equipment?
- Can I find the answer to questions by looking carefully at things?
- Can I collect my results and write them down?

Computing

In Computing, our topic is **We are Treasure Hunters** where we will be answering the following questions;

- Can I create a program?
- Can I debug an algorithm?

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Our topic is **Relationships** where we will be answering the following questions:

- Can I recognise and share my feelings?
- Can I talk about different types of behaviour and how others feel?
- Can I talk about the importance of not keeping secrets?
- Can I share my views and opinions with others?

Each week, we will also be looking at the UNICEF Right and Responsibilities for Children.

Polar Explorers

Geography

We will be answering the following questions;

- Can I tell something about the people who live in hot and cold places?

History

- Can I find out more about a famous person from the past and carry out some research on him or her?

Learning about and from Religion

We will be answering the following questions:

- Can I use a viewfinder to focus on a specific part of an artefact before drawing it?
- Can I make a clay pot/model?
- Can I add texture by using tools?

Maths

In maths, we follow a scheme called **Maths No Problem**. We will be answering the following questions;

- Can I add and subtract small numbers?
- Can I say what comes first, second and third?
- Can I say what is to the left or the right?
- Can I read, write and count to 20?
