LOOK at what we're learning



FS 1



Foundation Stage 2 —Oak and Willow Class




Year 3

Year 3 have become researchers this week; finding out lots of information to write non-chronological reports about seahorses and in maths they have been learning all about money.




Year 4




The bar chart shows the number of visitors to a museum in a week.
