English

We will:

- Apply phonics and sight words when reading and writing.
- Write simple sentences with capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
- We will be challenging children to use time conjunctions in their writing.
- Write instructions on how to plant a seed.
- Explore and produce work around the story 'The Tiny Seed'.



Geography

We will:

- Explore our local area by going on a trip to Braunstone Park.
- Identify features of a park.
- Create a map of Braunstone Park and identify key features of the park.
- Use knowledge of the area they live in to discuss what they like or dislike about the it.

Science

In Science we will be looking at plants. We will be:

- Naming a variety of plants including trees.
- Exploring flowering plants and trees, identifying and describing the basic structure.
- Using observational skills to draw a flower.
