decided to take to the streets of Braunstone, visiting Braunstone Park and the streets surrounding the school to do their bit for the community by litter picking. Well






On Thursday 7th October, BCPS celebrated **National Poetry Day** with a Poetry competition with our very own panel of judges.


BCPS Advisory Board—We need you!
