- Support the school's positive ethos, values and high expectations of all children by encouraging my child to follow the school rules.

- Attend parents' meetings organised by the school.
- Complete and return any electronic forms/paper letters as soon as possible.
- Encourage my child to be dressed in school uniform
- Make sure that children wear their PE kit on their PE days
- Make sure that they come to school each day with a drink in a named bottle
- Make sure that they bring their book bag to school every day
- Make sure that everything they bring to school is clearly named
- Avoid taking children out of school for holidays during term time.
- Ensure that your child arrives in time for the start of the school day and at the end of the day is collected promptly.
