- Learning phase 3 and 5 phonics
- Spelling sight words and common exception words

## Science

In Science this term we are focusing on  
Animals, including Humans

We will be;

- Exploring the life cycle of a sea turtle
- Exploring the life cycle of a human
- Basic needs for survival i.e. food, water, oxygen etc.
- Healthy living

## Maths

In Maths this term, we are focusing on number sense, place value and addition.

We will be;

- Counting to 100 and from any given number to 100
  - Reading and writing numbers up to 100
  - Identifying one more and one less
  - Partitioning numbers in different ways
  - Comparing and ordering numbers from 0 to 100
  - Recognising number patterns in 2, 5 and 10's
  - Adding two-two-digit numbers with and without renaming
  - Form numbers in the correct way and direction
- It would be useful if you could practise the above key skills with your child. If you are unsure of what activities to do, then please speak to the class teacher for additional support.

## Unit

### Geography

We will be;

- Place and Knowledge – Human and Physical features of Braunstone and around the UK.
- Locational Knowledge, Geographical Skills and Field work to – Name and identify the four countries of the UK and their capitals, name and locate the seven continents of the world and name and locate the five oceans of the world.

### History

We will be:

- Learning about hospitals in the past and present
- The importance of Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole
- Making our own statues

### Computing

We will be:

- Familiarising ourselves with apps and websites such as numbots, hit the button and phonics play.
